
CENSUS DATES – VET STUDENT LOANS

Overview

VET Student Loans Census Dates applies to the following courses:

- **SIT50322 Diploma of Event Management**
- **SIT50316 Diploma of Event Management** – Note: this course is superseded. From January 2023, all new students will be enrolled into SIT50322 Diploma of Event Management.

Applicants who wish to apply to the VET Student Loans income contingent loan scheme are provided with comprehensive information on Census Dates and related matters prior to enrolment. Please check our website for [VET Student Loans enrolment information](#).

Please note: There is a mandatory two-day “cooling off” period between the time your formal enrolment application is received and the completion of a Request for Commonwealth Assistance Form (VET Student Loans application). For more information on Census Dates please visit www.studyassist.gov.au

What does the Census Date mean for enrolled students who wish to access VET Student Loans?

The Census Date is the last day you can access a VET Student Loan or withdraw from a unit of study without incurring a debt. Withdrawal after the census date means a proportion of your tuition fees is debited from your VET Student Loan balance.

Remember: VET Student Loans is an income-contingent loan scheme. Your loan will be payable to the Australian Government administered by the Australian Taxation Office. Census Dates

SIT50316/22 Diploma of Event Management courses are 12 months (50 weeks including breaks) in duration. There are three fee periods (units of study) each with one census date.
